The process begins with the preparation of essential documentation required by the Djibouti Customs Authority. Key documents include the commercial invoice, packing list, bill of lading, certificate of origin, and any relevant import or export licenses.

What items cannot be brought into Djibouti?

Check the information below to be sure that you are complying with Djibouti customs regulations. 1 carton of cigarettes. 1 bottle of alcohol. 1 bottle of perfume or eau de toilette. Medicine for personal use. The following are goods which cannot be brought into the country. Intellectual or industrial property.

Importers must file the appropriate customs declaration, which formally distinguishes between goods intended for local consumption and those designated for transit.

Djibouti Customs regulations and procedures for importing and exporting goods at Djiboutian border. Duty free items, import-export restrictions.

Household products (washing powder, diapers, soap, etc.) are not considered as used HHGs. Their import can lead to customs hold and extra charges. Alcohol import is not prohibited.
