For international communications, Belgium has 5 submarine cables and a number of satellite earth stations, two of which are Intelsat, and one Eutelsat. ^"Belgium";

Which US Air Force bases are in Belgium?

United States Air Force bases in Belgium: Chievres and Kleine Brogel air bases. Belgium: Mons (strategic operations command of the joint armed forces, special operations command; NATO cyber operations center, Russia); Brussels (command of the US Army garrison Benelux); AVB "Shyevr"; Zutendal (US Vivt warehouses).

Does Belgium have a telephone system?

Domestically speaking, the country has a nationwide cellular telephone system and an extensive network of telephone cables. Telephone regulation is a national competency. The country code for Belgium is 32 and the international call prefix is 00.

How many mobile network operators are there in Belgium?

There are three licensed mobile network operators (MNO) in Belgium, Proximus (Belgacom), Orange Belgium (Orange S.A.) and Telenet /Base and numerous mobile virtual network operators (MVNO). A fourth license will be auctioned off by the government in January 2010.
